a) Background

- Name of group/club/society and school/college/university undertaking the project
- An official letter from the teacher/lecturer authorising the project
- Name, email address and contact number of the project leader, team members and teacher/lecturer

b) Description of the project

- Objectives/purpose/theme
- Achievable targets/results
- Expected learning outcomes/applications
- Project timeline
- Other organisations/guests that will be featured in the project
- Follow-up actions (if any)
- Success evaluation criteria

c) Information about World Vision

- What role does World Vision play in your project? How can we help?
- How would information provided by World Vision add value to your project?
