GIVING A TALK IN SCHOOLS

Student groups, clubs or societies that wish to learn more about World Vision or invite World Vision to give a talk can email a formal proposal to admin@worldvision.com.my with the subject line “School Engagement”.

The proposal would help us gain a better understanding of the purpose of the talk, and should contain the following information:

a) Background of the organising party

- Name of group/club/society and school/college/university requesting the talk
- An official letter from the teacher/lecturer authorising the talk
Name, email address and contact number of the person in charge and teacher/lecturer

b) Description of the talk

- Objectives/purpose/theme
- Achievable targets/results
- Expected learning outcomes/applications
- Time limit
- Mode of delivery (physical or online)
- Other organisations/guests that will be participating in the talk
- Follow-up actions (if any)
- Expectations (if any e.g. include a presentation/interactive activities)
We will consider your request, but we cannot guarantee that it will be honoured.
- Success evaluation criteria

c) Information about World Vision

- How would World Vision’s sharing add value to your event?
- How would you further utilise the information shared by World Vision?
